# SMS INTERNATIONAL SUMMER MUSIC SCHOOL AND FESTIVAL

# MISSION

To develop, in the west of Ireland, a world class summer music school and festival with the highest international standards of performance and teaching and with no barriers to admission based on financial disadvantage, age or current level of achievement.

Summer Music on the Shannon (SMS) Instrumental and Youth Opera programmes are designed to provide accessibility to international standards of music instruction and performance excellence. The music school and festival provides, for musicians of all ages and at all levels of achievement, programmes which stimulate inherent artistic talent through a wide variety of classes and rehearsals, plus participation in festival concerts. As participants in the SMS inspiring and enjoyable summer music school and festival, students will be encouraged to explore opportunities for the further enjoyment of music.

No audition is required for admission to one of Ireland's foremost classical summer music festivals. Musicians from eighteen of the world's leading symphony orchestras have participated in SMS for more than two decades; many of these internationally renowned musicians will again be joining our core faculty of musicians and music teachers for SMS 2017.

# LOCATION

SMS classes, rehearsals and performances are located in Counties Clare and Limerick, Ireland. SMS Festival performances will take place in the LIT Millennium Theatre, Limerick, St. Columba's Church, Ennis and at a number of heritage locations in Limerick and Clare, and along the Wild Atlantic Way and Lough Derg.. For visiting faculty, students and families, the 2017 SMS Residence, with spacious and fully-equipped apartments, will be located close to the LIT Millennium Theatre and Ennis. SMS is easily accessible by air via Dublin, Shannon and Cork Airports, and by train and bus from Dublin and Cork.

#### **YOUTH OPERA THEATRE 2017**

The SMS Youth Opera Theatre is a four-week programme of classes and performances. The final two weeks run concurrently with the Instrumental Programme, bringing instrumentalists and singers together in rehearsals and public performances in Limerick and Clare. SMS was founded upon the principle that all families should have access to music programmes which are designed to encourage and nourish individual artistic potential and does not, therefore, require auditions, or a prior identification of talent level, as a criteria for admission.

#### SMS 2017 OPERA PRODUCTION ELIZA & THE SWANS

commissioned by W11 Opera, London, 2015 John Barber, music; Hazel Gould, libretto

*Eliza & The Swans* is an adaptation of Hans Christian Anderson's magical fairy tale about a young princess who has to rescue her brothers from a spell cast upon them by the Queen, their jealous and evil stepmother who banishes Eliza from the castle and turns her brothers into swans each day. In a dream, a good fairy explains to Eliza that she can break this curse on her brothers by knitting eleven shirts from nettle for her brothers, but she must not speak a word until the task is complete, or all eleven brothers will die. While she is collecting nettles in the forest, Eliza meets - and is persuaded she should marry - a young king. However, because of the curse, she cannot speak and explain to him what she is doing.

The archbishop believes that Eliza must be a witch and she is condemned to be burned at the stake. Eliza finishes knitting the last shirt just as she is brought to the stake and she throws them to the swans as they come to rescue her. She is now able to speak and tell the truth about the evil Queen and prejudiced Archbishop. The burning stakes miraculously burst into flowers as the watching crowds cheer Eliza.
